Ryurik, Old Norse: Hrǫrikr, Grand Duke of NOVGOROD (830 - 879). *".. legendary Varangian chieftain of the Rus' who, according to tradition, was invited to reign in Novgorod in the year 862. () Rurik has been considered the founder of the Rurik dynasty, which was the ruling dynasty of Kievan Rus' and its principalities, and ultimately the Tsardom of Russia, until the death of Feodor I in 1598". → Svyatoslav I aka Svyatoslav I Igorevich, Grand Duke of KIEV (943 Kiev - 973)

→ Vladimir I Sviatoslavich (Sviatoslavych) "the Great" aka "Saint Vladimir", Prince of Novgorod & Grand Prince of Kiev KIEV (958 – 15. July 1015). Adopted Christianity and made it the state religio

→ Yaroslav I Vladimirovich "the Wise", Grand Prince of Kiev and Prince of Novgorod (978-1054), m. Ingegerd Olofsdotter of Sweden.

→ Anna Agnesa Yaroslavna of KIEV (1030 - 1075), m. King Henry I of France.

→ Philip I "the Amorous" (French: L'Amoureux), King of France (1052-1108)

→ Louis VI "the Fat" King of France (1081-1137)
